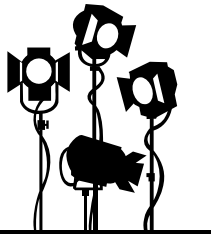
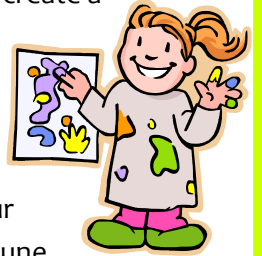
SUMMER CAMP PROGRAMS

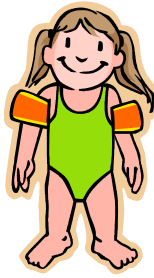

TINY TOT ADVENTURE DAYS

AGES: PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

Bring your little one out for a fun filled day of adventure! We'll play games and activities, go swimming, create a snack, make a craft, and have story time. Your children will be supervised by an enthusiastic group of counselors who are dedicated to providing your child with an outstanding camp experience. Tiny Tot Adventure Days have a lower counselor to camper ratio than our other summer camp programs to offer your little one the attention and supervision he/ she needs. Campers should bring a bagged lunch and come dressed with their swim suit under their clothes. We will have swim and water fun time during each Adventure Day, weather permitting. Please be sure to apply sunscreen on your child before they come, and pack them a towel and any flotation device they may need. The cost is \$20 per day, please RSVP 48 hours in advance, a registration form is required.



REQUIRED SWIM TEST

All minors between the ages of 9-16 are required to take and pass a swim test to visit the swimming pool without their parent or guardian present. Minors are required to enter the water at the 3-foot end of the pool, swim one length of the pool unassisted (without a flotation device) and exit the 5-foot end of the pool by themselves. If the minor passes, their Membership Card will indicate the test has been successfully completed. If the test is not successfully completed on the first attempt, the minor will be given another opportunity to take the test. If the minor cannot pass the swim test requirement, he/she will not be allowed usage of the pool without a parent or guardian present. This policy is in place to ensure the safety of everyone using the Residents' Club facility.
