EARTH HOUR

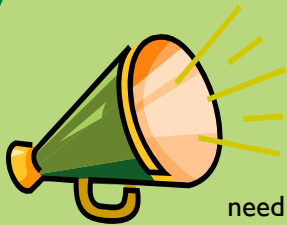
Saturday, March 27th 8:30pm

We request and RSVP for all events so that our staff can prepare accordingly in order to offer the best service possible. Please let us know prior to the event if the number in your party changes. The Residents' Club plans activities and programs as to not incur a debt to the Founders Pointe Homeowners Association. No part of the Homeowners Association dues are allotted to paying for the activities and programs held at the Residents' Club. In order to plan activities without a budget, the Residents' Club must charge an admission fee that will recover 100% of the activity or program expenses. To ensure that all expenses are recovered by an activity or program, there is a minimum number of participants needed to register and participate to hold all activities and programs. A few activities and programs have limited capacity and participation is only available on a first come first serve basis. If the minimum required number is not met during registration, the activity or program will be cancelled.

Guests & Age Restrictions

All residents are allowed to bring guests with them to events they are attending, including summer camp programs. Occasionally pricing may be different for guests versus residents. Children attending an event without a parent must be potty trained. Residents' Club staff is not responsible for changing diapers, and will contact parents in the event their child has an accident.
